#### **Veritas School at Cleveland Park Stables**





On Wednesday, October 5, FoRR was joined by a group of 14 students and two teachers from the **Veritas School**. They have volunteered with us previously through an out-of-the-water litter cleanup, but because they had additional people joining them this year, we were able to engage them by removing invasive plant species at the rain gardens in Cleveland Park Stables. They spent over two hours clearing out more than half of the largest bed and did a great job of identifying the desirable versus non-desirable vegetation. This was a wonderful way to educate and engage young members of our community, and conduct the maintenance necessary within Stables park. They were super enthusiastic and did a great job! We hope to have them out again soon.
