FoRR joined Save Our Saluda on November 10 for a Streambank Stabilization Workshop. The workshop included an indoor morning session with speakers on topics including methods for repairing eroding streambanks, controlling exotic invasive species, and for establishing, enhancing, and maintaining riparian buffers to protect streambank property and downstream water quality.
