

Action Alert: DHEC Public Meeting

Support pollution cleanup in the Southernside Community.

On **Thursday, June 6, at 6:00 pm**, SC Department of Health and Environmental Control (SC DHEC) is hosting a Public Meeting at **Mountain View Baptist Church (111 Cagle St., Greenville)**. They will present and discuss their Proposed Plan for the cleanup of pollutants at the Bramlett Road site located in Greenville's historic Southernside community, located along the Reedy River upstream of Unity Park.

The site houses a former Manufactured Gas Plant, which is leaking dangerous pollutants into the Reedy River and its surrounding wetlands. Neighborhood leaders and partner organizations have been advocating for a complete restoration and full cleanup of the Bramlett site for years. Immediate action is needed to protect our Reedy River watershed and its residents from the coal tar ash contamination, including known carcinogens that significantly exceed regulatory standards.
